5. The candidates whose applications are found in order, shall be issued admit cards (online) to appear in recruitment tests. 6. The selection process will consist of Physical Efficiency Test (PET), Physical Standard Test (PST), Written Examination, verification of original documents and Detailed Medical Examination (DME)/Review Medical Examination (RME).

7. Medical Examination to assess the fitness of candidates will be conducted in terms of Uniform Guidelines for Recruitment Medical Examination for GOs and NGOs in CAPFs and ARs issued vide MHA U.O. No. A.VI-1/2014-Rectt (SSB) dated 20.05.2015 and A.VI.1/14-Rectt (SSB) dated 24.08.2015 and as amended from time to time by the Government.
